2010 Portland Hempstalk - Vending Information

We are currently giving Hempstalk 2010 vendors a chance to reserve booth space.

Hempstalk 2010 vending spaces are sold through our on line portal (<http://www.hempstalk.org>), where you can see which spaces are available and which spaces are sold. You can view, select and pay for the exact spot you want. You may also call (800)723-0188 to reserve a booth or make a payment.

General booth spaces are \$300, food booth spaces are \$600 and blanket vending is \$125. On May 15, 2010, we open vending sales to the general public. Spaces are reserved on a first come, first served basis.

We can not allow you to vend without meeting these requirements.

- You are responsible for providing the canopy, tables and other necessary supplies for your booth. (*Please be aware that this years site is almost entirely grass. This requires adapting booth erection*). You are also responsible for maintaining the space in and around your booth. Please be respectful. If you put it down, pick it up, and if you pack it in, pack it out.
- The event will begin at 10:00 am. all weekend long. We ask that vendors be open from 10:00 am. through 9:00 pm. both days. Load-in will take place on Friday afternoon/evening, and Saturday and Sunday before 9:00 am.
- All vehicles must be off the site by 9:00 am. Saturday and Sunday.
- Hempstalk reserves the right to refuse any application and to withdraw acceptance of any application under which circumstances vendor's booth fees will be refunded in full by August 31. Hempstalk reserves the right to restrict or prohibit any activities determined by the Hempstalk Staff to interfere with public access and/or event programming, or which will reflect poorly on the overall event.
